

RECAP

- In the fall of 2024, there was a total of 8 new recruits hired for DNETV. 4 for the BBDE station and 4 for the SS Station.
- One recruit in each station arrived already possessing their mandatory certification levels (FF1, Hazmat, and FF2)
- The 6 remaining recruits were sent to the Lanark County Recruit Program at the Ontario Fire College Regional Training Center (RTC) in Mississippi Mills.

RECAP

- Part of Ontario Regulation 343/22 on Firefighter Certification stated that all new firefighters hired after July 1, 2022 would need to be certified to NFPA 1002 Standard for Fire Apparatus Driver / Operator Professional Qualifications.
- DNETV Fire Rescue made a decision to upgrade all of the existing pump operators that have current OFC Pump Ops certification to the NFPA 1002 certification prior to the July 1, 2026 Certification deadline.
- In 2024 stated to investigate teaching the NFPA course in house via a Learning Contract with the Ontario Fire College and using members that are already certified to teach.
- Goal was to reduce costs by having the training on normal scheduled training nights that were to be already paid out as well as removing the Offsite Training costs and travel time.

- As Adjunct Instructor through the OFC, Deputy Chief was able to monitor all online progress through the OFC Training Portal. On average it took approximately 20 hours per student to complete, and they were paid for that amount.
- 20 hours @ \$25.64 per hour = \$512.80 per FF
- \$512.80 x 11 FF = \$5,640.80

ACTUAL TIME TAKEN (in class)

 The fact that we were dealing with mostly experienced operators that just needed training on the new changes from the OFC Pump Ops course to the NFPA Standards, we were able to adjust the Lesson Plans for each night accordingly. The total time in class is as follows:
